


The order of play is dependant on the number of players in each team [4,5,6] according to the schedule opposite, first 4 players will always play each other in order of ability (number 1 player being the best etc). Doubles pairings can be any 2 players though the 'best' doubles pair should be D1 and the second best D2.

All matches are best of 3 sets to 11 points, deuce sets [10-10] must be played to 2 clear point wins eg 12-10, 13-11, 14-12, etc. 2 serves each player before changing server, except at deuce when each player has only 1 serve at a time.
